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Millennium Pipeline Company, L.L.C. (**Millennium**) is proposing to construct the Minisink Compressor Project (**Project**) in Orange County, New York which will enable Millennium to increase the firm natural gas transportation service that it can provide to an existing interconnect with Algonquin Gas Transmission, LLC (**Algonquin**) to approximately 675,000 dth/day. The Project involves the construction of a new compressor station to be located at 107 Jacobs Road in the Town of Minisink, Orange County, New York (**Minisink Compressor Station**).

The Project does not involve the replacement, abandonment by removal, or abandonment in place of facilities determined to have polychlorinated biphenyl (**PCB**) compounds in excess of 50 parts per million in pipeline liquids. Therefore, Resource Report 12 is not applicable.
