MILLENNIUM SUBMITS VALLEY LATERAL PROJECT APPLICATION FOR FERC APPROVAL

The Millennium Pipeline Company submitted an application to construct the Valley Lateral Project to the Federal Energy Regulatory Committee (FERC). The project includes the construction of an approximately 7.8-mile lateral natural gas pipeline that will connect Millennium's mainline in Orange County, New York to the CPV Valley Energy Center in Wawayanda, N.Y.

"Our application is the next step in this project and allows FERC to undergo a comprehensive and transparent environmental review of Millennium's plans to construct a safe and reliable natural gas lateral pipeline to serve the CPV Energy Center," said Millennium President Joseph Shields. "Our filing provides details on how Millennium will design, construct and operate this new facility with a core focus on safety and respect for landowners and local natural resources."
