MILLENNIUM DONATES \$10,000 TO WAWAYANDA TO HELP DEVELOP A NEW TOWN PARK

The Millennium Pipeline Company announced today that the company has provided the Town of Wawayanda with a \$10,000 donation to help develop a new town park on Ryerson Road in New Hampton.

The park, which will provide a recreational facility to people living on the eastern side of the town, is scheduled to have a little league field and nature trails, among other amenities. The town's other park, Shannen Park, is located on the west side of town.
